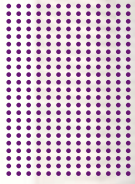


Our country is currently benefiting from a demographic dividend. In the Union Budget 2024-25, the government introduced several schemes and initiatives designed to support skill development and to bridge the employment gap among youth. AU Ignite, a flagship program of AU Foundation serves as a platform that fosters skill development and promotes employment opportunities for the youth, contributing to nation-building.

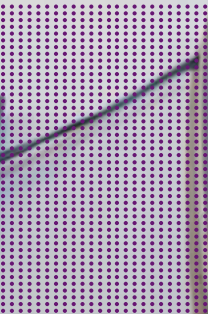
The program caters to youth from marginalized segments, enabling them to acquire relevant skills and earn a livelihood while ensuring financial stability. Its aim is to empower youth from underprivileged backgrounds who have limited resources but immense potential to succeed if given the right guidance. Skilled trainers at our academies mentor these individuals and provide the knowledge needed to help them excel in their professional journey.







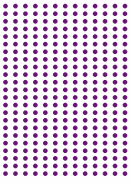

UNLOCKING YOU



The program offers practical, industry-relevant training to youth aged 18–30 in four major disciplines: BFSI, Healthcare, Tourism & Hospitality, and IT-ITeS. Through this initiative, AU Ignite oversees comprehensive monitoring from regular assessment and evaluations to creating employment opportunities that lead to financial independence. In addition to the academic curriculum, industry visits, seminars, field-expert sessions and more are frequently conducted to prepare students for real-world professional challenges.

The trainees are also trained in soft skills such as communication, personality development, financial literacy and more as part of the skill development program, which give them an extra edge on the job. Under this program, AU Foundation organizes placement drives and job fairs, aiming to provide 100% placement opportunities. This year, the trainees not only got placed in reputable companies in tier-2 and tier-3 cities, but few of them also got placed overseas with handsome packages. Additionally, two specially-abled trainees got placed at reputed organisations, starting their financial journey.





To maintain quality standards at the academies, several advancements have been implemented. These include the deployment of biometric machines for attendance, provision of uniforms and books to the trainees, and the introduction of a Learning Management System (LMS) app for holistic development. Additionally, new assessment and certification agencies have been onboarded to authenticate, evaluate and guide trainees throughout the program.



Under the flagship of AU Ignite, the Future Skills program enables trainees to gain advanced skills such as Salesforce and Data Science & Full Stack Development, among others, helping them secure jobs in various IT companies. In FY 24, over 120 trainees were placed in leading IT organisations across the country.

AU Bano Champion, *Maidan se Manzil tak* is revolutionizing the lives of children and youth in rural and semi-urban locations of Rajasthan through guided sports training. Through Bano Champion, sports is becoming a crucial tool for fostering both physical and mental health, shaping the next generation to face future challenges and seize the opportunities with strength, discipline, and confidence.

Since its inception, AU Bano Champion has seen over 8,100 youth across 60 rural and semi-urban locations enroll in the program, with 6,000 of them regularly engaged in rigorous training and competitions in athletics, throwball, football, volleyball, boxing, wushu, and kabaddi. For many children, especially girls who make up 35% of the participants, AU Bano Champion has opened doors to a world of opportunities they never imagined. These children, once confined to the boundaries of their homes and localities, are now excelling at district, state, and national and international levels under the guidance of professional coaches. Over 100 expert coaches and sub-coaches are mentoring these young athletes, turning potential into excellence.



From Grassroots to Glory

Out of 2500+ athletes who competed in district, state, national and international tournaments, the medals tally has been as below:



Additionally, more than 10 athletes have been selected for national teams in sports like football and kabaddi, and over 20 participants have joined advanced sports training programs at premier institutions such as the **Sports Authority of India (SAI)** and **Bengaluru Football Club**.

The program is also focused on empowering local coaches by providing them world-class training from institutes like: **Transtadia University**, **Inspire Institute of Sports (IIS)**, **All India Football Federation** and **Rajasthan Athletic Association** etc.



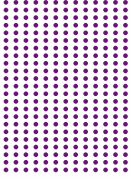

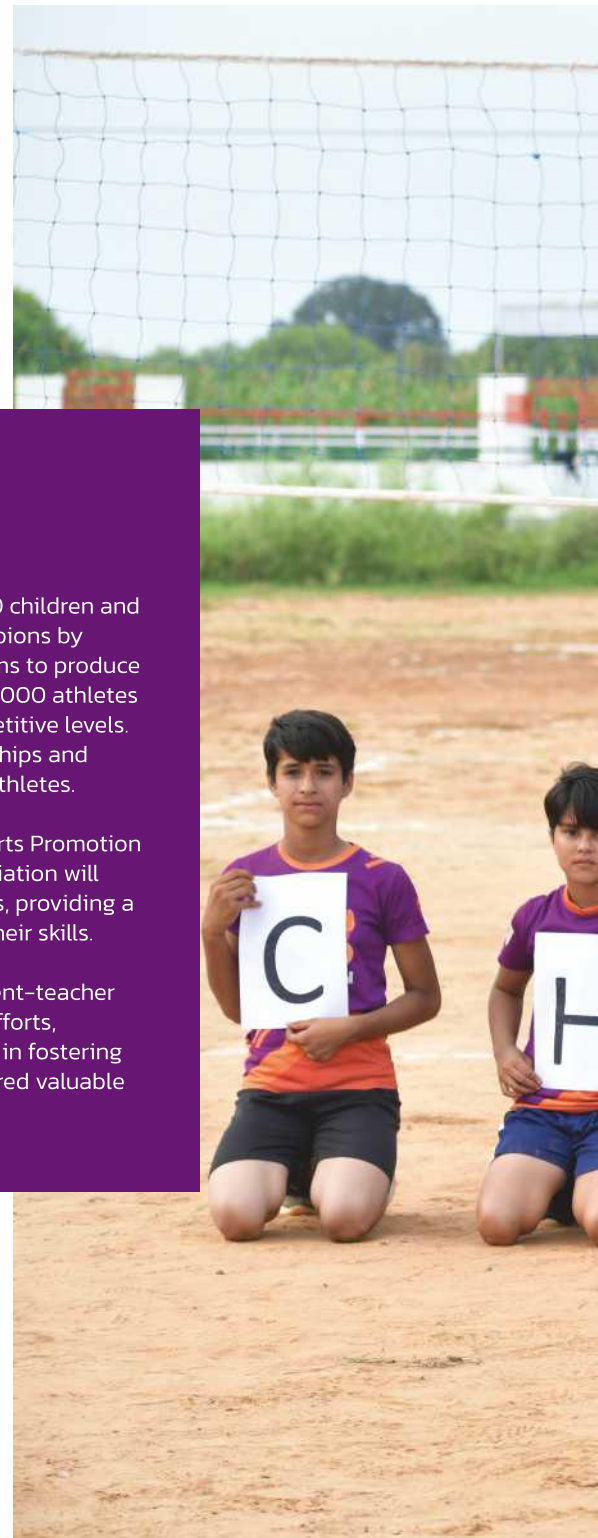


Fueling Athletic Dreams

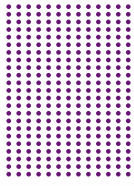

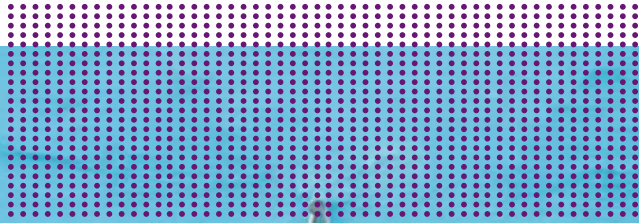




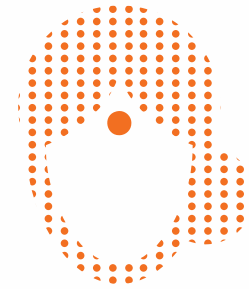

Now expanding its reach to Madhya Pradesh and thirteen additional districts of Rajasthan, AU Udyogini conducts its operations in 2 states and 33 districts of India. The program embodies our commitment to sustainable development and women empowerment through livelihood enhancement.



The program operates through two synergistic models: Community Enterprise and Individual Women Entrepreneurship Model.

AU Udyogini Bazaar is a one-business-one-shop model marketplace that enables women to operate as wholesalers providing necessary supplies in nearby areas.



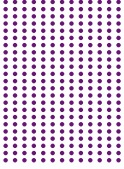

The Community Enterprise Model includes initiatives like Maa Annapurna Masala, a women-led community enterprise delivering quality spices and pure mustard oil, supporting 110 women across 8 centers. Nirjhari Women Artisans Producer Company, a registered producer company, trains over 200 women in crafting home furnishings, apparel, and recycled paper products.

In contrast, **the Individual Women Entrepreneurship Model** empowers women to start independent businesses, aligned with their interests and capacities. We provide seed money, Entrepreneurship Development Program and Bookkeeping training for capacity building, and handholding support to facilitate entrepreneurship, enabling women to become financially independent and confident entrepreneurs.

By providing comprehensive support through financial training, digital literacy, market linkages, and government scheme integration, we help women become empowered home-based entrepreneurs in their own geographical vicinity.





AU Udyogini's core philosophy revolves around creating a ripple effect and it has been such that today, our Udyoginis can be seen training other women in their region to become empowered.



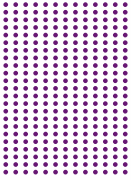
The program has engaged 2,920+ women members, with 213 women earning a regular income through community enterprises. Additionally, 1,200+ individual women entrepreneurs have started micro-businesses, showing growing profits.

Our target group includes women from marginalised backgrounds, with over 20% widowed, separated and divorced. Rigorous research is involved in every aspect of AU Udyogini alongside a strict process, ensuring effective interventions and minimal dropout rates.

By supporting women entrepreneurs and community enterprises, AU Udyogini creates a lasting impact, fostering economic growth, social empowerment, and sustainable development.

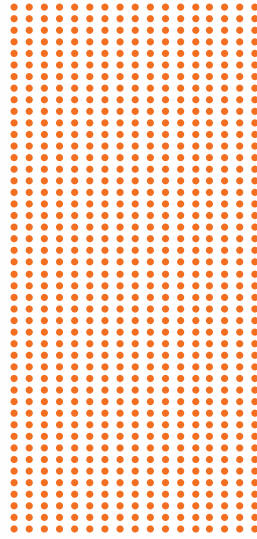

Nurturing Nature, Sustaining Future

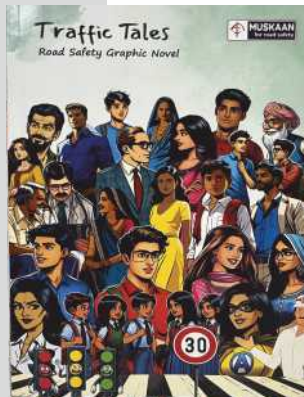
Promoting environmental conservation and sustainability, AU Kartavya's initiatives focus on enhancing green infrastructure, fostering renewable energy, and creating eco-friendly spaces for communities. This includes the 'Neer Nidhi Nirman' project, under which a sewage treatment plant is installed, and 776 trees have been planted at PHED Office in Jaipur, solar panel installations at Wagar Seva Sansthan in Banswara, and an year-long adoption and maintenance of a 7-Acre green zone park in Amritsar.





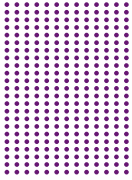
